

Dinghy Project for Free

11 Plus, sail number 406, for renovation requires good home

Originally designed by Eric Parkin and offered by Kitboats as an alternative to the Mirror dinghy built of ply on a pine frame. The two piece mast can be stowed inside the dinghy and can be stepped in one of two positions to allow for single or twin sail use.

This dinghy requires hull and decks re skinning with ply and two pieces of frame replacing due to it being out of use for many years. The mast, boom and foils are in good condition. Main and jib are good. The rigging is stainless steel and also in good condition.

A full set of plans is available.

A road trailer which also requires renovation comes with the dinghy.
